**WHEREAS:** the Fashion Club at the College of Charleston has met all requirements set forth by the Compass.

**WHEREAS:** the Student Organization Review Board has met and determined that the Fashion Club at the College of Charleston is deserving of being a budgeted organization.

**THEREFORE:** BE IT ENACTED BY THE SENATE OF THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, THE FOLLOWING

**SECTION I:** Be it enacted that the Student Government Association of the College of Charleston approves the Fashion Club for becoming a registered student organization.
